- Resilience to deal with major emergencies that demand significant resources or require
  the support from other services and agencies, whilst continuing to deliver business as
  usual activity across the county
- Prevention to raise awareness of the risks people face from fire and other types of emergency




#### **Referral Partners**

- Vulnerability to fire can come as a result of vulnerability to other health and lifestyle issues
  - smoking,
  - living in isolation,
  - cold homes,
  - mental health,
  - alcohol and drug addition,
  - physical disabilities that impact on ability to escape a property,
  - falls and frailty
- Achieve this by having an effective referral pathway
  - Home Safety Check/Safe & Well Check
