- Fortunately with the help and support from Speakup the Pandemic was not the end of my employment ambitions
- Through Zoom and MS Teams ...
- I have worked co-producing and leading on the Speakup training programme ...
 "Making Things Better for People with Learning Disabilities and Autism"
- We have been delivering this training to Health Professionals, paid Carers and the Medical Students at Sheffield University over Zoom and MS Teams





 Currently I am working on an Advocacy Project, with 3 colleagues from Speakup, to help people detained in Mental Health Units to get a better understanding of how to access Advocacy Services



 I know from personal experience how important this work is for inpatients because I am currently detained in hospital in Bradford





 With the support I have from Speakup, I am able to continue doing my work over Zoom and sometimes I have been able to travel independently to Speakup's offices in Rotherham



• I enjoy working for Speakup ... it is giving me a purpose ... experience ... training in areas I will be able to use in the future





- And the bonus to me
- Now I am a paid employee
- I get a Wage





 I think my story shows that, in spite of a Pandemic Emergency and additional Mental Health issues ...

 With support and Reasonable Adjustments, a person with a Learning Disability and Autism can work, earn a wage and make a valuable contribution
