Practitioner scheme

- Become a registered public health professional (UKPHR).
- Practitioners should be working autonomously and contributing to policy and programme development with at least 2 years+ of practice at AFC Band 5 and above, Skills for Health Levels 5-7
- 12-18 month part-time. Completion of three commentaries demonstrating competence against all 34 of the UKPHR practitioner standards based on relevant work undertaken.
- Structured programme of support, including a mentor, sessions to support completing commentaries, and priority access to a workforce development programme (about ten sessions total), including six FPH workshops.
- Entry via application form and interview. No cost to participants.
 Scheme opens in January.

Population Health Fellowship

- Augment your current expertise.
- Open to NHS staff (clinicians, G6+) and other relevant public sector workers, to help them develop as population health practitioners.
- National scheme funded by HEE but managed regionally.
- Includes a learning programme covering the NHS's eleven population health learning objectives.
- Fellows are embedded with a regional host and supervised to complete appropriate project work.
- 12-month, two day a week, salary cover provided.
- Application process opens Feb, fellowship starts Sept.
