UKPHR Specialist Registration by Portfolio Assessment

UKPHR's Specialist Registration by Portfolio Assessment (SRbPA) registration is an alternative way of registering with UKPHR at Specialist level for those who have not undertaken the Standard Route of obtaining Specialist registration and are not on the GMC/GDC Public Health Specialty registers.

This registration route is aimed at those who are already working at Public Health consultant level and can demonstrate that they meet all UKPHR's Knowledge and Show How competencies.

Y&H are developing a support programme for this which includes: matrix mapping, 1:1 support and masterclasses/CPD

Public Health Apprenticeships



- A programme of work based study to develop knowledge, skills and behaviours
- Combination of theoretical knowledge and competency based assessment
- Nationally accredited qualification
- Mixture of "on-the-job" and "off-the-job" training
- Related to a job role




Apprenticeships that support public health careers

L3 - Community Health and Wellbeing Worker


Entry level - Improve health, prevent ill-health and reduce inequalities
