Recruiting a Level 6 Public Health Apprentice in 2023/24.

As we firm and/ or make workforce development decisions for the New Year, this newsletter serves as a refresher of the information currently available to the region to support staff members interested in upskilling and the recruitment of new entrants for the Level 6 Public Health Practitioner apprenticeship standard.

Employers are encouraged to engage directly with the apprenticeship teams of training providers they wish to work with.

Accessing Level 3 Community Health & Wellbeing Worker Apprenticeship Training.

Leeds City College is an approved training listed on the standard based within the Yorkshire and Humber region.

Key attributes of Leeds City College's provision include

- 1. Apprentices can enrol anytime they are ready to join the course.
- 2. Apprentices attending college once a month to access in-person training.

- 3. Training assessors also visit apprentices at their workplace monthly to support learning.
- 4. Modules are designed around the 10 competencies of the standard
