As a public health community, workforce development also presents us with an opportunity to widen participation and reduce inequalities during recruitment exercises/ activities to enhance social mobility for

- 1. People with lived experiences (ill health or impoverished communities)
- 2. Underrepresented groups or communities
- 3. Former volunteers
- 4. People who wish to start a career in health with little or no experience

The <u>Social Mobility Commission</u> defines social mobility as the link between a person's occupation or income and the occupation or income of their parents. Higher social mobility means there is a weak link and vice-versa. The commission again in <u>this article</u> stated that;

'Apprenticeships boost social mobility'

This article also highlighted the need to be strategic in the approach to ensure active measures are put in place to facilitate this.

It is on this premise employers are encouraged to consider improving social mobility within their local communities. The resources may support you with your decision making.

Identification and recruitment of a Degree Apprentice

In <u>a UCAS post</u>, degree apprenticeship training providers identified 'willingness to work hard' as one of the key attributes and aptitudes of successful apprentices.

Key considerations for upskilling staff is ensuring that their existing/new role maps onto the duties in the <u>L6-PHP standard</u>. For those that are not closely

related, employers in consultation with the chosen training provider(s) may consider providing the relevant opportunities through placements or rotations.

For recruitment of new entrants, employers may consider drafting a job description that is underpinned by the duties in the standard. Examples from 2021 recruitment around the country can be found <u>here</u> (choose from 'Job Ads with JD-PS).

Another key consideration is ensuring potential apprentices have their level 2 functional skills in Maths and English certificates (GSCE equivalent) ideally before the start of the program.
