Accepted Applications from Yorkshire & Humber at UWE.

Ten applications from Yorkshire and Humber have been accepted at the University of West England to start the Public Health Practitioner degree apprenticeship programme this autumn.

Excitingly, this year, we have applications from two NHS trusts within the region.

There may be more application(s) by the end of autumn as some employer(s) are in the process of recruiting/ enrolling with the University of Sunderland.

The University of Salford and Coventry both enrol in January 2023. Both providers have in-person offers on their respective campuses.

Level 3 Community Health & Wellbeing Worker Apprenticeship

On another positive note, Yorkshire and Humber has taken lead nationally in enrolling the first cohort for the <u>Level 3 Community Health and Wellbeing Worker apprenticeship</u> running.

Leeds City College the training provider within the region has innovatively enrolled members of staff involved in supporting the health and wellbeing as their first cohort.

Taking a page from this approach may suggest employers/ commissioners consider including the standard in the workforce development plans for community-based projects.
