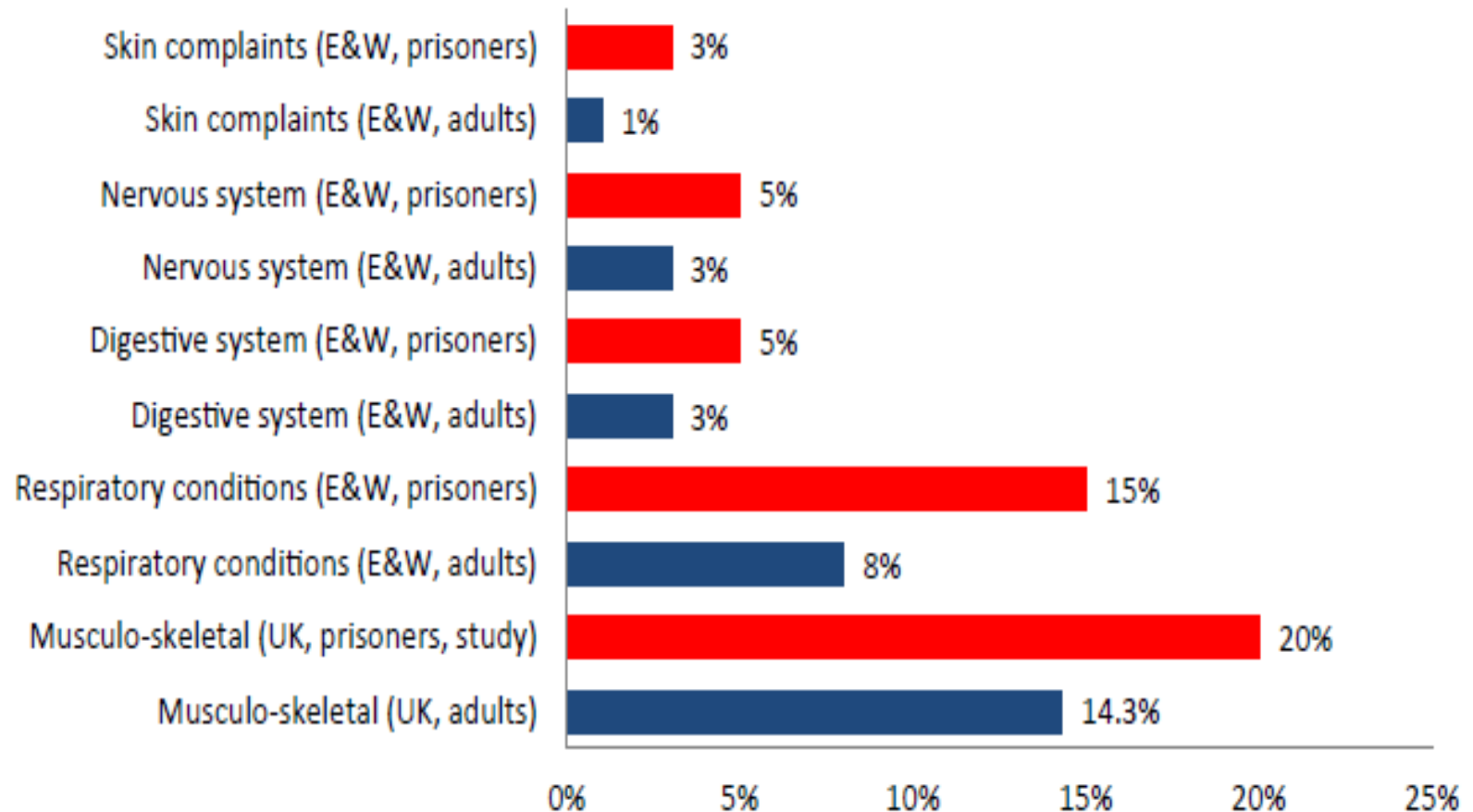

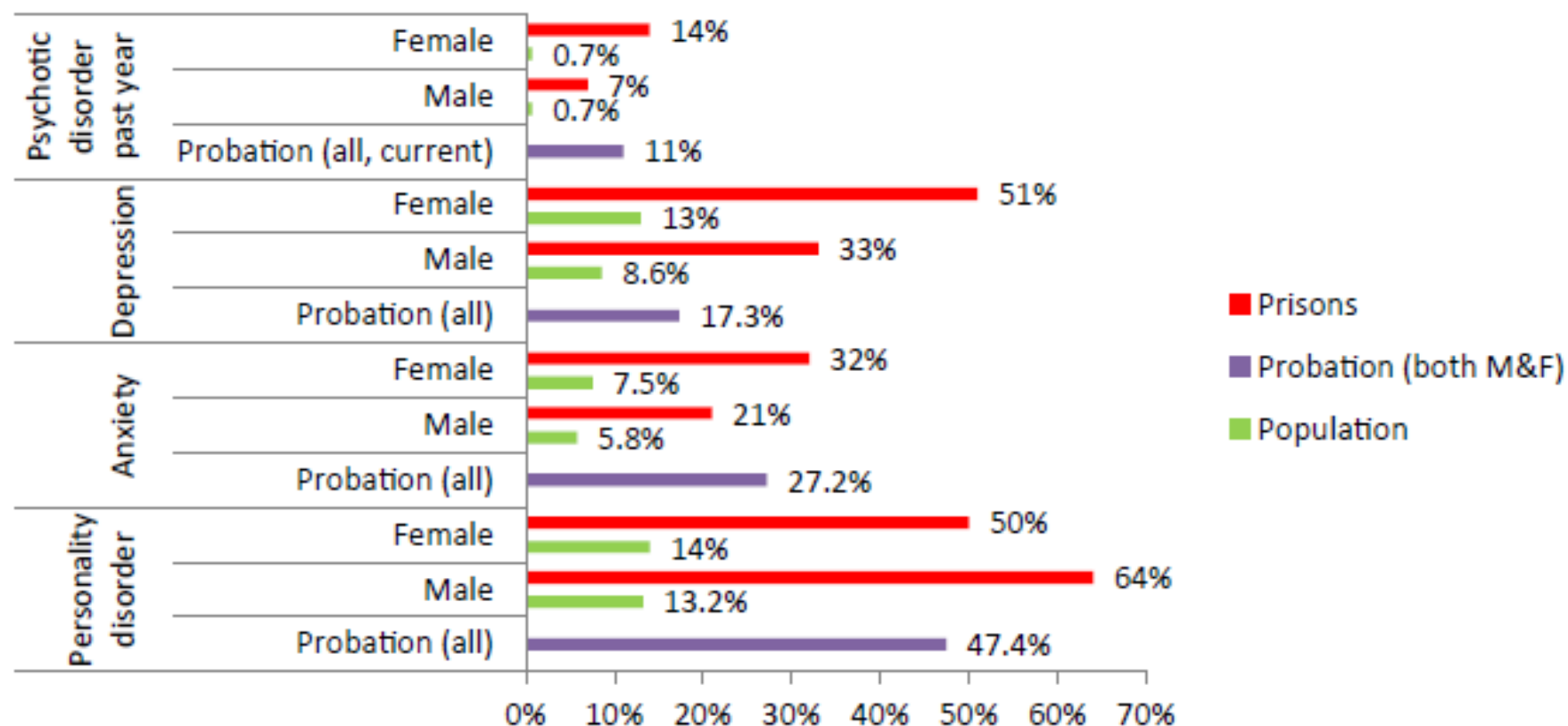

- How many have a mental health issue?

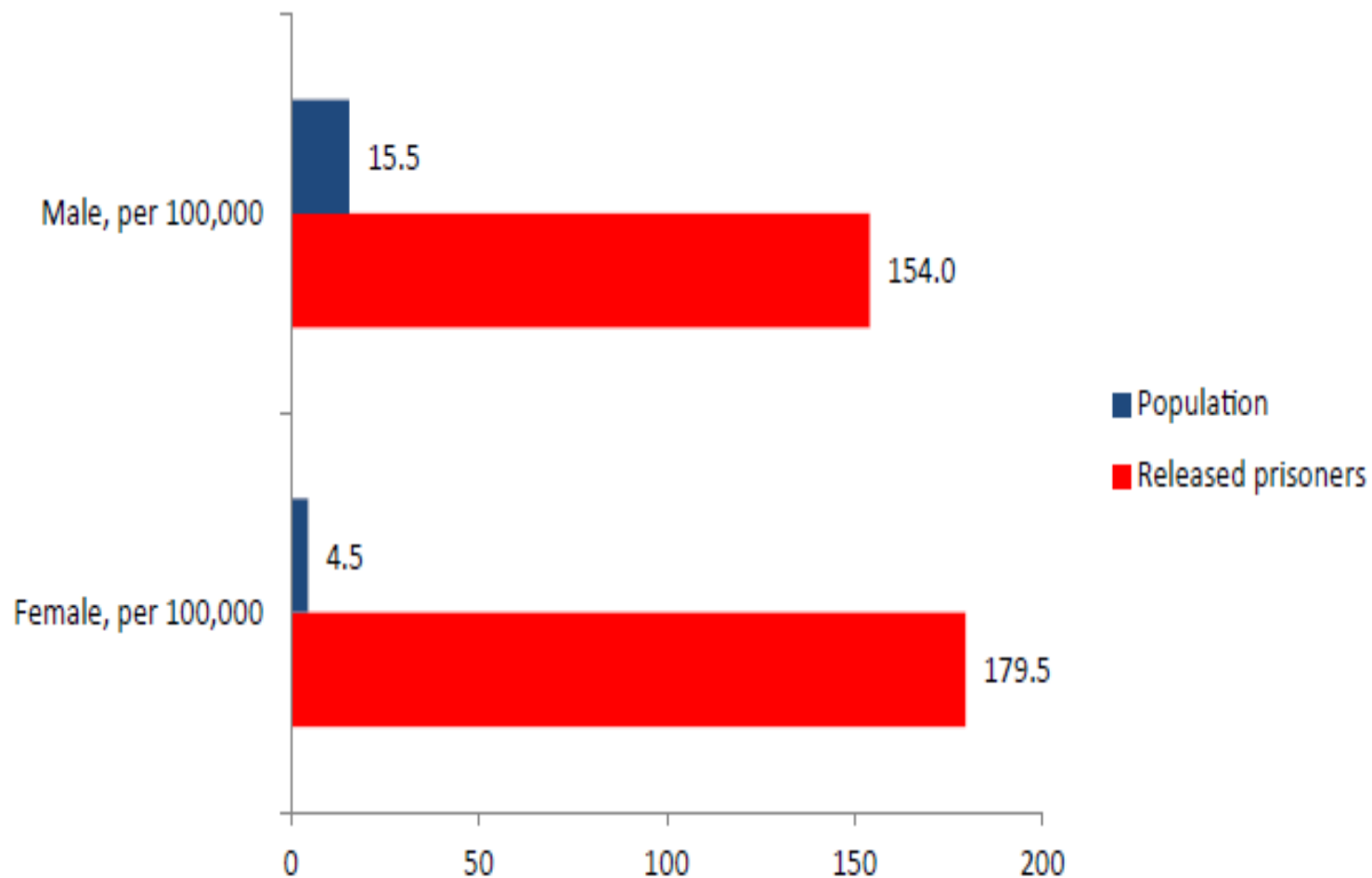
