Our model

- General Practice identify new patient registration as coming from an area of high risk of LTBI.
- Patient informed and made aware contact will be made for a blood test.
- Referral added to SystemOne template and sent to New Arrivals Team (Bradford District Care Foundation Trust).
- Patient contacted and invited for IGRA blood test.
- Flag 4 data used as a safety net until GPs referring confidently.
