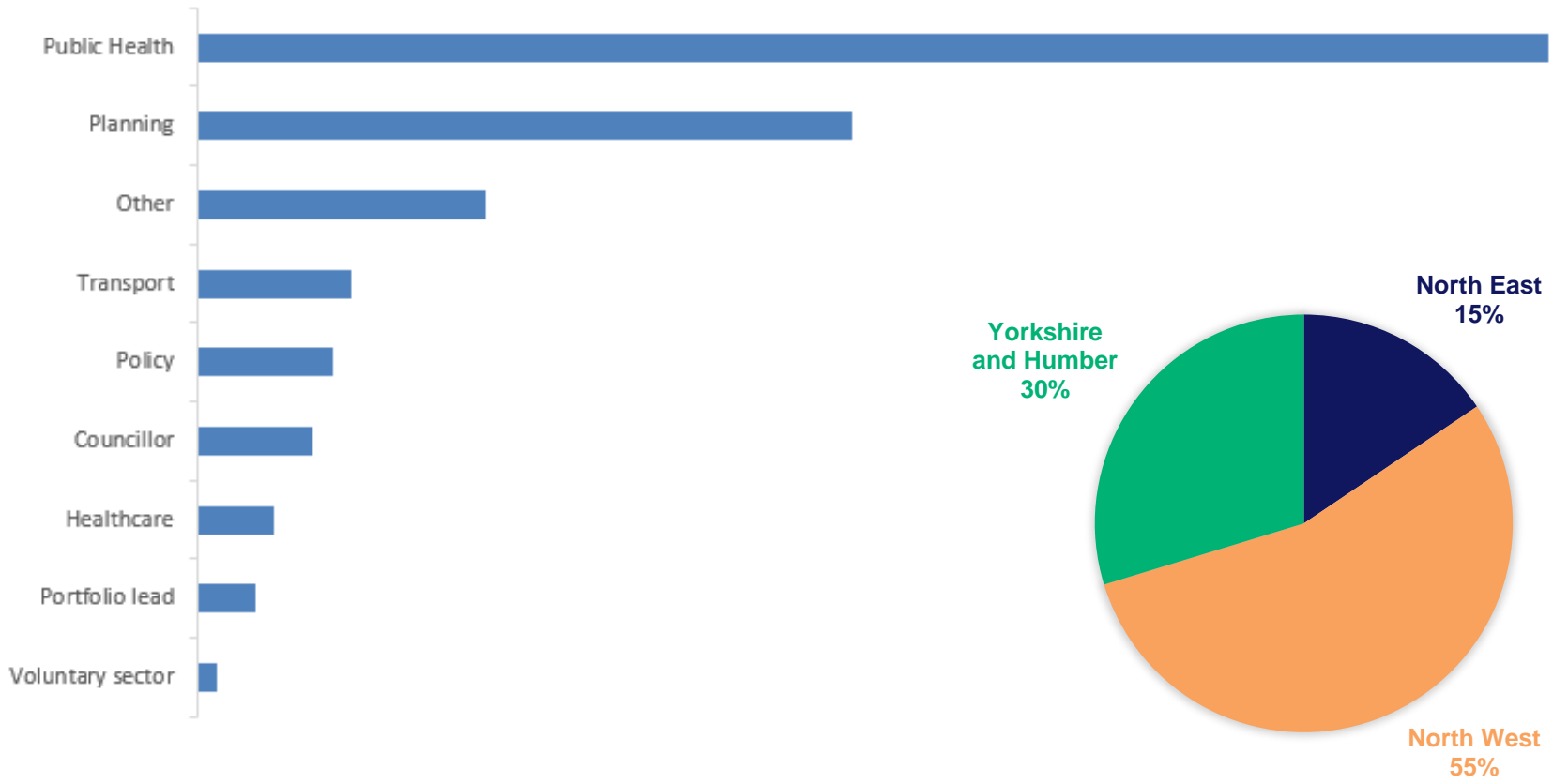
Encourage Public Health and Planning co-production across the North of England to make places healthier.

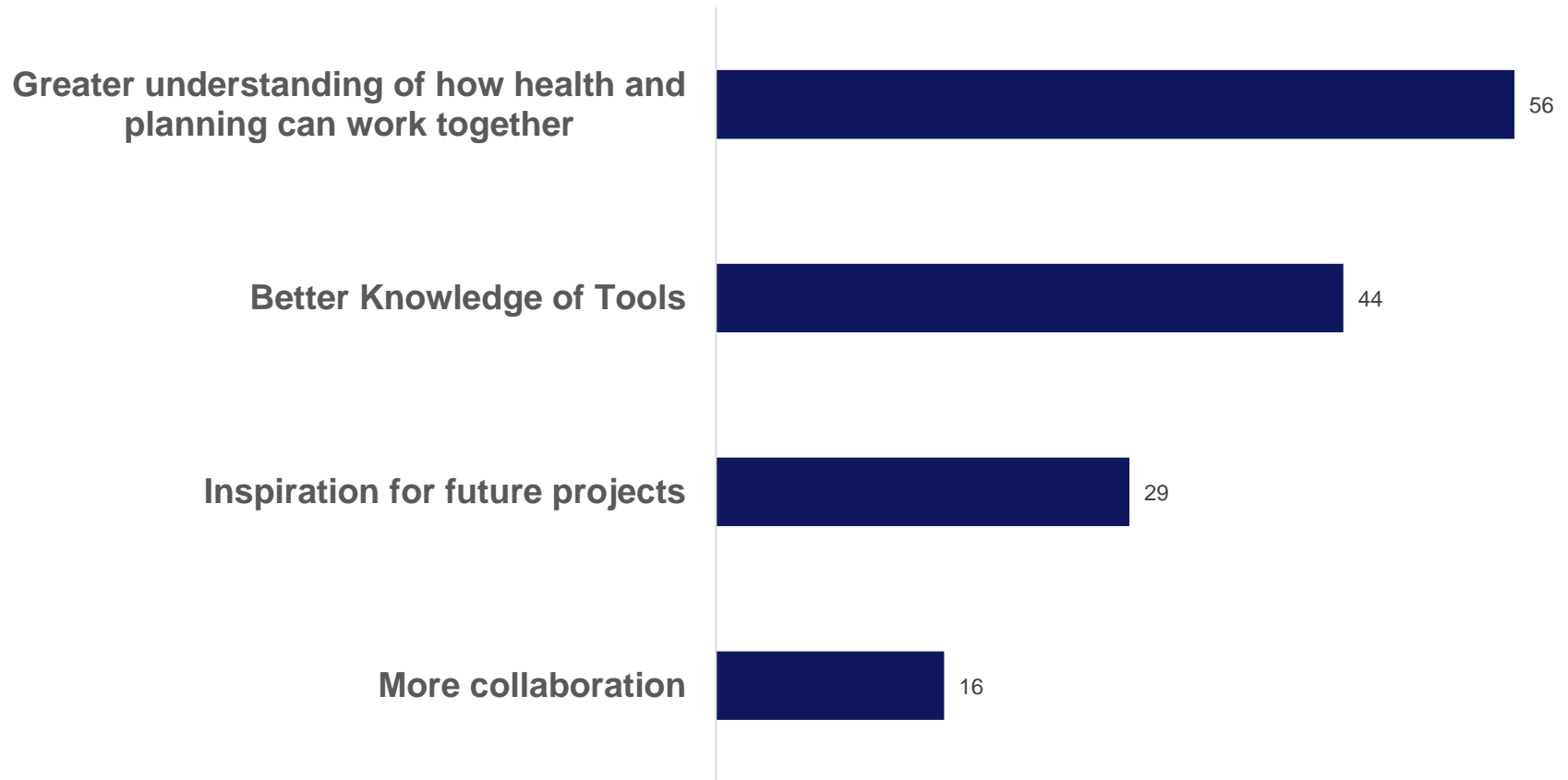

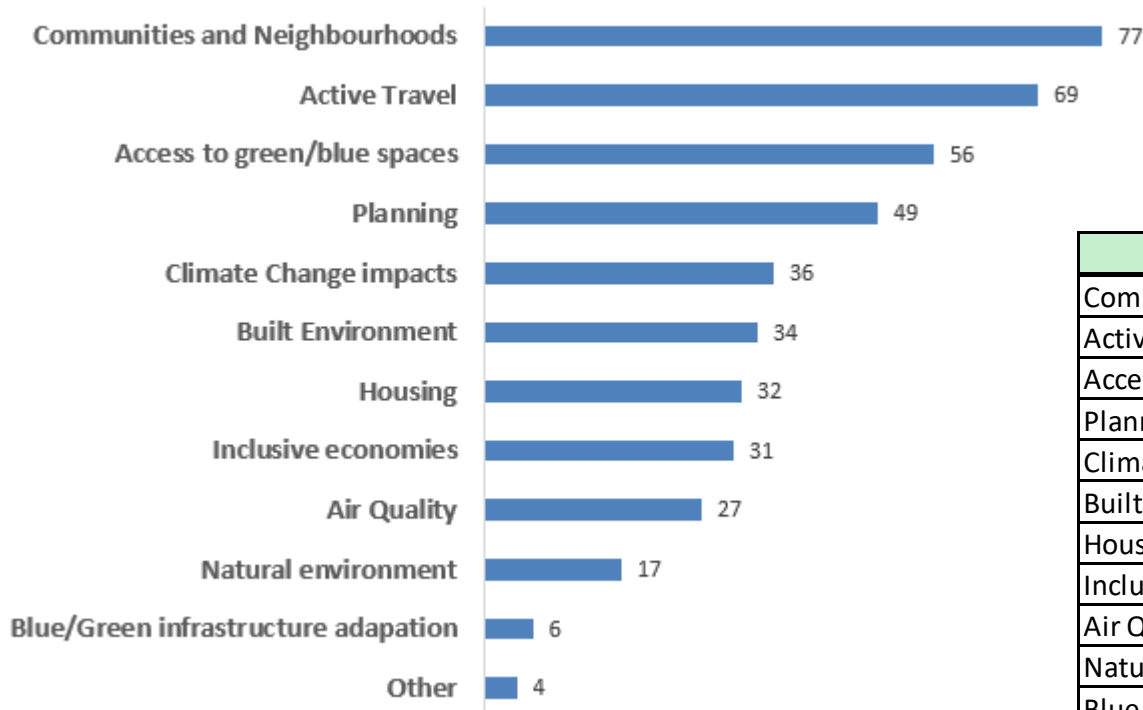
